### **For Year 10 Parents**

The information below comes from the School's Combined Cadet Force run in collaboration with Bangor Grammar School. It offers many opportunities to our pupils and refers to the joining process.

#### **CCF Enrolment Evening**

CCF Enrolment for potential recruits in Year 10 will take place from 1915 in Bangor Grammar School Assembly Hall and Atrium on the evening of Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017.

The evening will start in the Assembly Hall where there will be a short presentation on life in Bangor Grammar School CCF and the opportunities available to cadets. I would encourage all parents to attend this, even if older siblings are or have been involved in CCF. At the end of this presentation there will be the opportunities to ask CCF staff any questions that you may have.

If you wish your son or daughter to join the CCF for what will be a trial period until the end of October, you will need to decide whether they would like to join the Navy or Army Sections and will be able to complete the attached Application and Data Capture Form. Paper copies of the attached form are available from Bangor Grammar School Reception and will be available on the night.

The MoD has a rather unique approach to sizing uniforms and so rather than guessing, recruits will be able to try on uniform in Changing Rooms so that they order the correct sizes on the form.

At the end of the trial period, if your son/daughter wishes to continue in the CCF you will need to pay their fees of £45 for the year at our last Parade Night before October Half Term (Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> October).

To avoid bank charges we would prefer cash (in an envelope) but if you are paying fees by cheque, please make it payable to Bangor Grammar School.
