- ▶ 'Macbeth'- read the plot summaries and familiarise yourself with this and the main characters. Use <http://www.sparknotes.com/> to assist you too. Use spidergrams to summarise key points about the characters and themes. Use a flow chart to summarise the plot .
- ▶ 'An Inspector Calls' – read the complete play and complete the questions on Act 1 p73-74.
- ▶ Read the short story 'The Withered Arm' by Thomas Hardy. Again use spidergrams to summarise key points about the characters and themes. Use a flow chart to summarise the plot .
