

Year 13 Careers Planning Programme



From Monday 18th – Thursday 21st June, a series of Careers Planning activities will be running for pupils currently in Year 13 as you prepare to make important decisions about your future study and/or employment early in Year 14. This programme is an important step in enabling you to make well-informed and appropriate decisions about your career path after completing your A-Level study.

You will be required to attend the following:

- A Careers Briefing with Mrs McKinley
- A UCAS Registration workshop
- A Personal Statement workshop
- A one-to-one Careers interview with an NI Careers Service Adviser/ member of the Careers Team



In order to register for the Careers Planning Programme, please complete the following steps:

1. Access the Registration Form on OneDrive using the sign up link which has been sent to your school email address. Your username will be your school username followed by **@c2ken.net** (e.g. jbloggs001@c2ken.net) and your password will be your existing C2k password.
2. Select **either** Monday 18th or Tuesday 19th June. *
3. Select **ONE** **UCAS Registration workshop** on your chosen day. **
4. Select **ONE** **Personal Statement workshop** on your chosen day. **
5. Select **ONE** Careers interview slot on either Wednesday 20th or Thursday 21st June.
