Dear Parent/Guardian

We greatly appreciate your full support regarding our uniform policy and helping our pupils maintain pride in their School appearance.

On another matter, I would ask you to remind your daughter that she must comply with our policy on the use of mobile phones in School. In particular, remind her that her mobile phone should be kept in her locker and **only used in an emergency in the designated locations**. It should never be used to take photographs or videos in School unless permission is granted by a member of staff.
