YEAR 12 - GUIDELINES FOR MOCK EXAMINATIONS, 2019 7th-18th January 2019

- Full attendance at school is vital. No absence for revision purposes should be taken. The Senior School Study Room is available for supervised after school study.
- 2 Ensure you know exactly when each of your exams is to take place. Put up a copy of your timetable in a prominent place at home and keep checking it. The hall will open for the morning session at 8.55am and the afternoon session at 1.25pm.
- Arrive in good time for each exam. <u>Be at the door opposite L3 by 8.50am/1.20pm</u>. Leave all bags, notes, coats, mobile phones etc in your locker.
- When you enter the exam room go to your seat quietly. Seats will be allocated on a daily basis according to subjects being taken. There should be no talking in the exam room or in the area immediately outside it afterwards, as other exams may still be in progress.
- You are to stay for the full length of each exam. In the unlikely event of you becoming unwell during an exam, let one of the supervising staff know immediately.
- 6 If you are too unwell to come in to school for an exam:
 - Inform the School by telephone immediately (Phone 91475340).
 - On return to School, make immediate arrangements to reschedule the missed exam(s).
- You are not required to come to school on a morning and/or an afternoon when you have no exam.
- You may leave school between a morning and afternoon exam or you may stay in school to revise. You may use the Library if there is space available.
- 9 Mobile phones should not be brought into the examination room.
- 10 Correction fluids such as Tippex should not be used. Pencil cases should be clear plastic only.
- Any pupil who has any work or controlled assessment outstanding may be asked to complete it in School during the exam period.
