This is a fantastic opportunity for any pupil considering a career in the justice system. The programme includes using tailored and age-appropriate legal resources to build a case, which will be acted out in a criminal trial in a real court, in front of a real judge.

This competition will run between June 2019 and November 2019, with the winning teams from each regional heat advancing to the national final in March 2020.
