Dear Parents/ Guardians

We have recently had a pupil in the school diagnosed Hand, Foot and Mouth disease. This is a very contagious disease and we would ask you to be mindful of the symptoms if your child becomes unwell. The symptoms include:

- A sore throat
- A temperature above 38 degrees
- Not wanting to eat
- After a few days, mouth ulcers and a rash will appear

Hand, foot and mouth disease normally clears within 7-10 days. We would ask that while your child still feels unwell that they are kept at home due to the contagious nature of this disease.
