

If you wish to attract my attention, you should raise your hand.




The following statement will be read to you just before you start the exam



Drop Off Arrangements at School

Use Valentine Road only

By car – parking outside School and then use pedestrian gate

 If mobility is an issue, vehicles enter by Valentine Road main gate and drivers follow instructions

On the Assessment Day
