Competition Information and Rules

How will the competition be judged?

- The competitor/team with the highest score (percentage) will be the winner.
- Should there be more than one combination on the same test score, marks for walk will determine the winner.
 If a tie still exists, then the collective scores will be taken into consideration. This is in accordance with standard dressage scoring.

GENERAL RULES

- All riders **must** wear appropriate footwear and a safety hat securely fastened at all times.
- Hoodies are not permitted whilst on horseback.
- If spurs are worn they must comply with Pony Club rules.
- General rules, for this event, will be under those followed by British Dressage.
- All ponies/horses must be ridden in a bit in compliance with British Dressage rules.
- A responsible adult must be appointed, by the School, to act as Chef d'equipe and be present with the team/individual on arrival and during the competition. The Chef d'equipe is responsible for the conduct of his/her team/individual at all times.
- Upon arrival, riders must report to the Show Office to collect their competition number.
- JUDGES AND STEWARDS DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- Any queries regarding results must be made within 15 minutes of the completion of the class.
- Any rider or school representative showing unsporting behaviour will automatically be disqualified.
- The organisers wish to remind competitors and spectators that equestrian activities can be dangerous.
- A rider can compete in both the prelim, novice and elementary classes.
- The same rider/animal combination cannot compete more than once unless competing in classes 5 and 6.
- A horse/pony can compete no more than twice.
- All competitors, riding as part of a team, are eligible for individual placings.
- Team selectors should ensure that riders are competent to ride at their chosen level.

CLASS 1 and 2 – Primary Individual and Primary Intro Individual

- These classes are open to **PRIMARY SCHOOL** pupils only.
- Primary School competitors can compete in any of the classes except Classes 3 and 4.
- The same rider/animal combination cannot compete more than once unless entering
- Please note that classes 1 and 2 will run in the afternoon to accommodate those pupils sitting the AQE test.

CLASS 5 and 6 - Novice and Elementary

- The same horse/rider combination taking part in these classes are permitted to compete in both the Novice and Elementary classes but cannot complete in classes 1-4.
- Classes are open to anyone aged 19 or under and in full time education.

TEAM EVENT

- Each team must consist of three riders. The teams must be nominated before the event (ie. when making entries). Amendments, to the nominated team, can only be made due to a withdrawal. Their substitute must already have been entered in the competition.
- All scores count towards the team score.
- Schools may join together to form a mixed team. Only teams with all members from the same school can
 qualify for first place in the team event.
