Contribution Fees

Policy for students starting from September 2013

- No tuition fees
- Contribution fees
- €3,000 in 2018/19
- Apply through SFNI
- Not means tested
- Contribution Fee Loan available
- Repayable



Maintenance Loan

- Up to £4,840 if living away from home
- Up to £3,750 if living at home
- 25% of the loan is means tested
- Remainder is not means tested
- Apply through Student Finance NI
- Loans are repayable



Maintenance Grant

- Up to £3,475
- The Maintenance Loan will be reduced when a Maintenance Grant is payable
- Paid in three instalments
- Means tested
- Not repayable unless a reassessment is required

Special Support Grant



- Paid instead of Maintenance Grant for some students
- Same amount as the Maintenance Grant
- Does NOT reduce the Maintenance Loan amount
- Means tested
- Evidence will be required to determine eligibility

- Help for students who have a disability
- Assessed through Student Finance NI
