As you know, all junior pupils take part in daily reading practice to work towards their Accelerated Reader target. Every pupil is encouraged to read for 30 minutes per day and book quizzes are then taken during school hours to measure reading progress. In light of the current exceptional circumstances we propose to allow pupils to quiz from home on a temporary basis. This will allow pupils to continue to read for pleasure and work towards their targets.

To ensure reading completed at home during this time is both accurate and meaningful please ensure that;

- Students use www.arbookfinder.co.uk to check if the book they are reading has a quiz. (all school Library books are clearly labelled)
- Check that the book is suitable for their reading level. (Recorded in English workbooks or available on their Accelerated Reader homepage)
- Try to ensure that any quizzing is completed without help.

To access their Accelerated Reader account at home, students will need to log into My-School – click on View All and then select Custom where they will find the link to our school account. All pupils must follow this link. Usernames and passwords will not work if they simply search for Accelerated Reader. In the event of any password difficulties at home, please contact the class teacher via Google Classroom.
