

Glenlola Collegiate School in Bangor has been awarded a prestigious Eco-Schools Green Flag by the environmental charity Keep Northern Ireland Beautiful. The Eco-Schools Programme is the world's largest Environmental Education programme and aims to make environmental awareness and action an intrinsic part of the life and ethos of a school. Our application was described as excellent, and the judges were very impressed with the wide range of activities undertaken throughout the year.



The internationally recognised Green Flag is this highest award given to Eco-Schools and symbolises excellence in the field of environmental activity. Glenlola's Eco Council, ably led by Year 14 prefect Autumn Hawthorne, delivered a programme of events designed to improve the biodiversity of the school grounds, educate on the importance of sustainability, decrease our carbon footprint, and reduce waste. This also included planting over 100 native trees on site to form our "Autumn Wood". Our reaccreditation is a fitting way to end our Eco year and the members of the Eco council should be very proud of their efforts.
