Entry to Year 14 in August 2024

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

I am writing to advise you of the arrangements for current Year 13 pupils regarding entry into Year 14 in August 2024.

Please note:

1. The 'Criteria for Entry into Senior School 2024' will be outlined in the letter accompanying the examination results in August and is available on the School website. Girls who meet our criteria for entry **can apply to return** to School by completing the form accompanying their results, indicating whether they confirm their original choice of subjects, or nominating amendments to those choices.

For girls hoping to enter Year 14, this form should be returned by 12.00 noon on Tuesday 20 August.

The Senior School Fund payment of £100 for entrance to Year 14 will be added to your School Gateway account. This is a contribution towards the additional provision made for Senior School pupils and a range of subsidised Senior School events and activities. It would not be possible for the School to make these provisions without these funds and we thank you for your support.

2. For some girls, return to School will be subject to the outcome of an interview. **Interviews will be held on Thursday 15 August and Tuesday 20 August for entry to Year 14. It is important that girls wishing to return for A2 study are available on these dates. Those required to attend for interview will be notified by the School.**
3. All pupils in Senior School are required to wear the Senior School skirt. You are reminded that the regulation skirt length is **knee length for all pupils**. (*a useful way to check this is if her skirt touches the floor when she is kneeling*). Please ensure that your daughter's skirt fits her properly. (*An indication of a good fit is, if your daughter can pinch at least 2cms along each side seam when she is standing*). Skirts deemed to be too tight or shorter than knee length will not be allowed. The stockists have suggested that, if your daughter is not of a standard size, you might ask her to go into the shop to be measured. A skirt can then be ordered specifically for her. However, they do request that this is done as soon as possible to ensure availability for the beginning of term.

28 August	Year 14 Induction – half day
30 August	First full day
