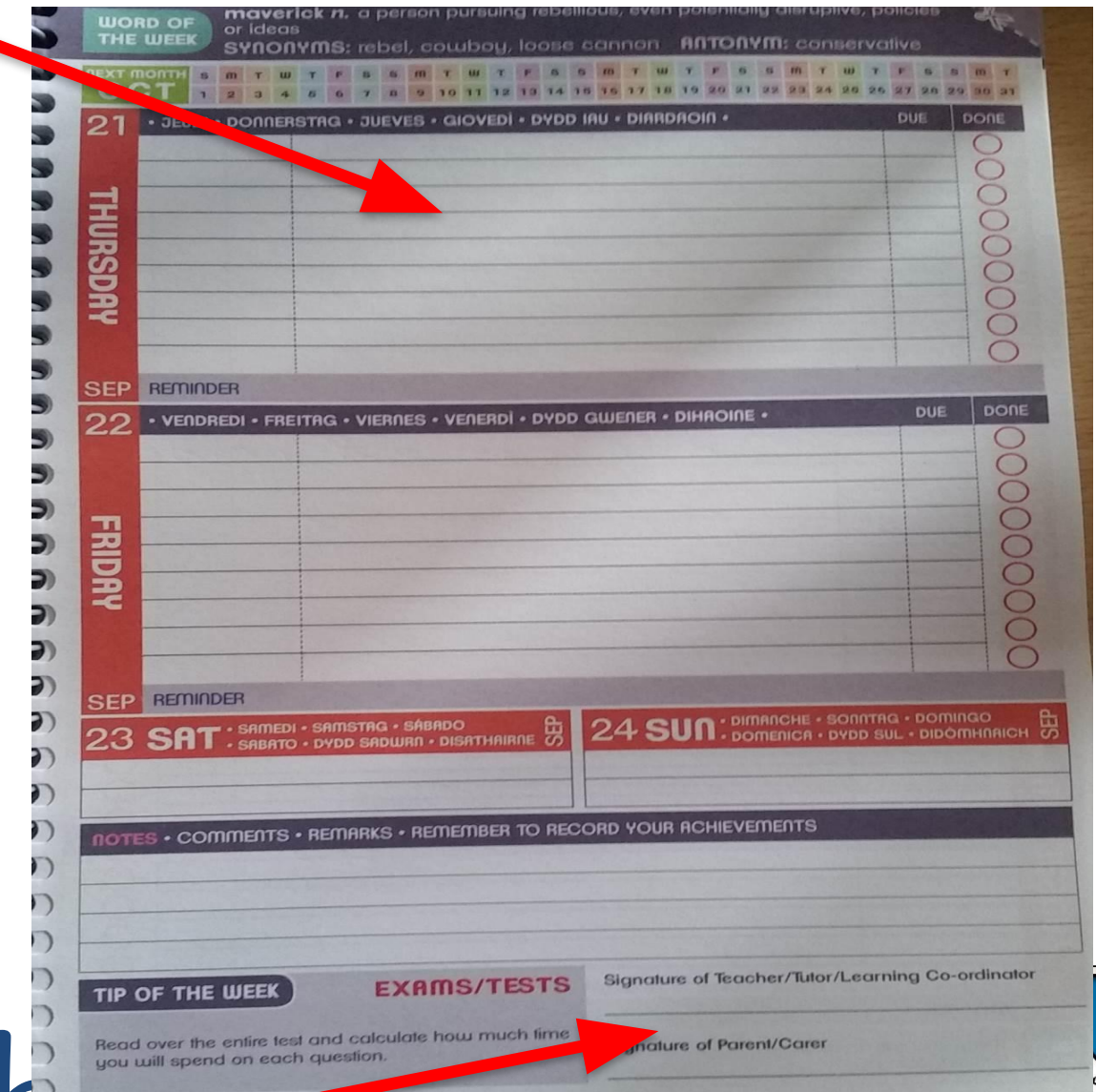

- ❖ Note required

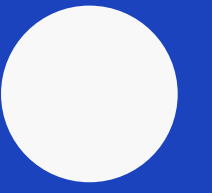

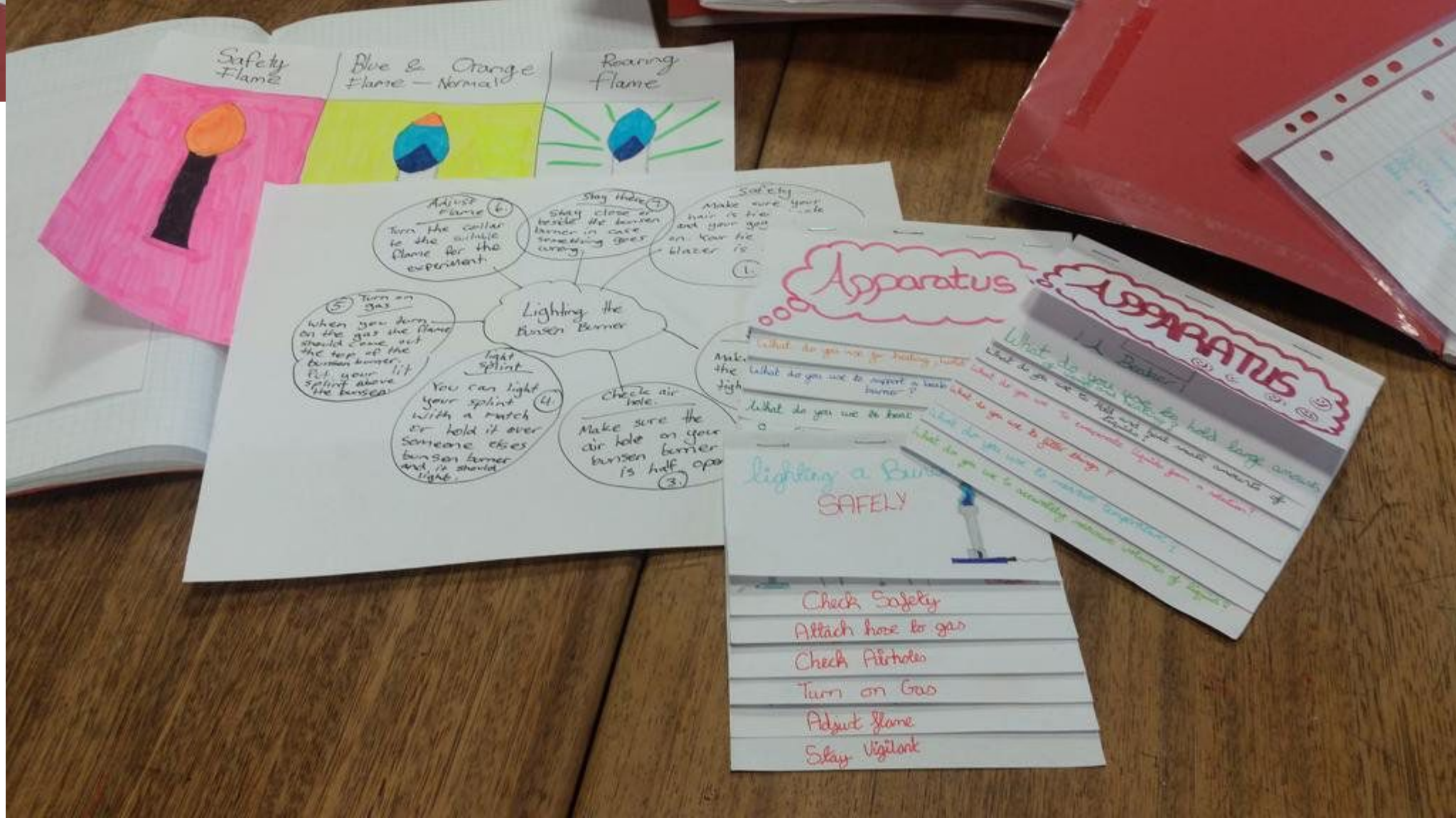
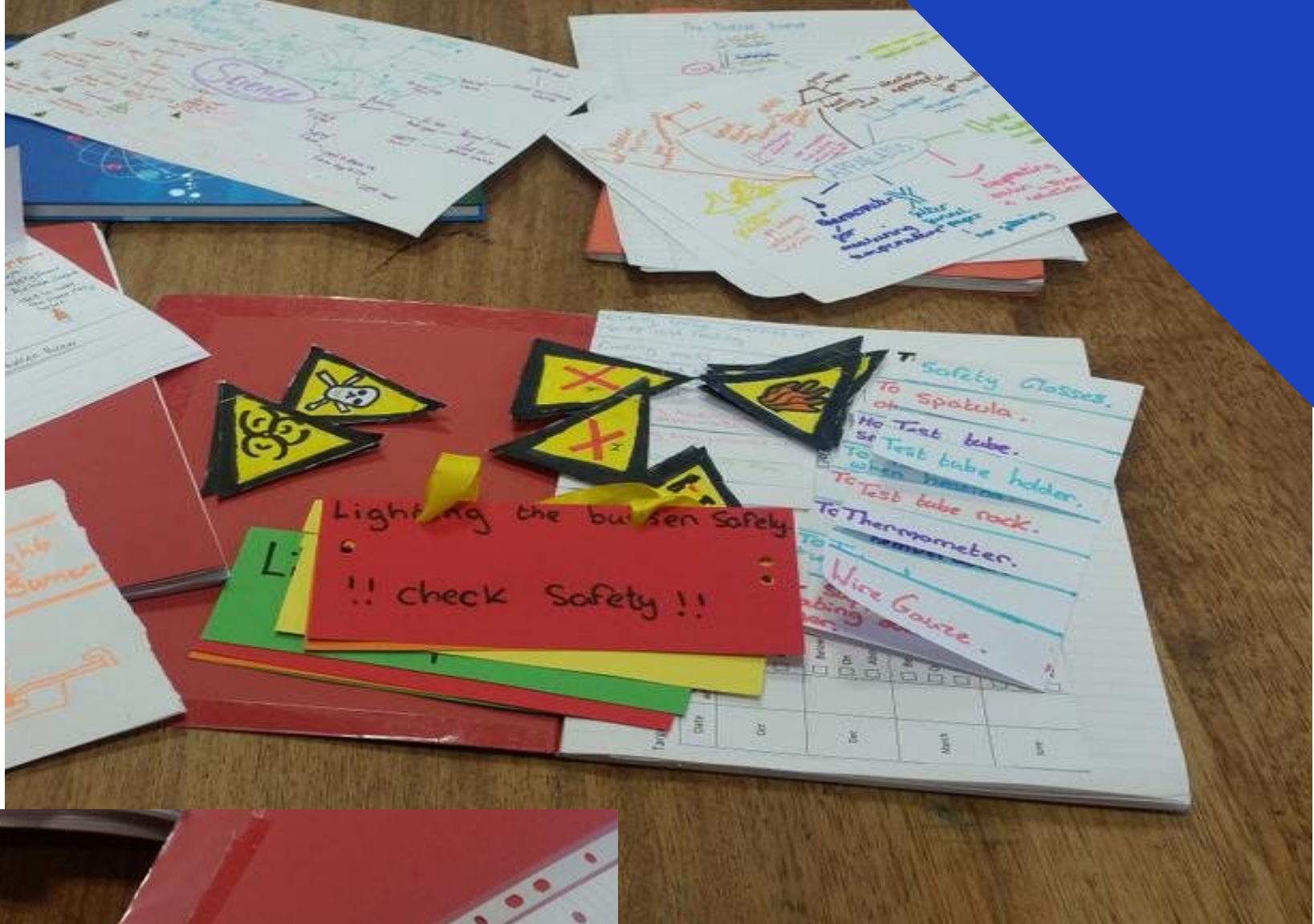
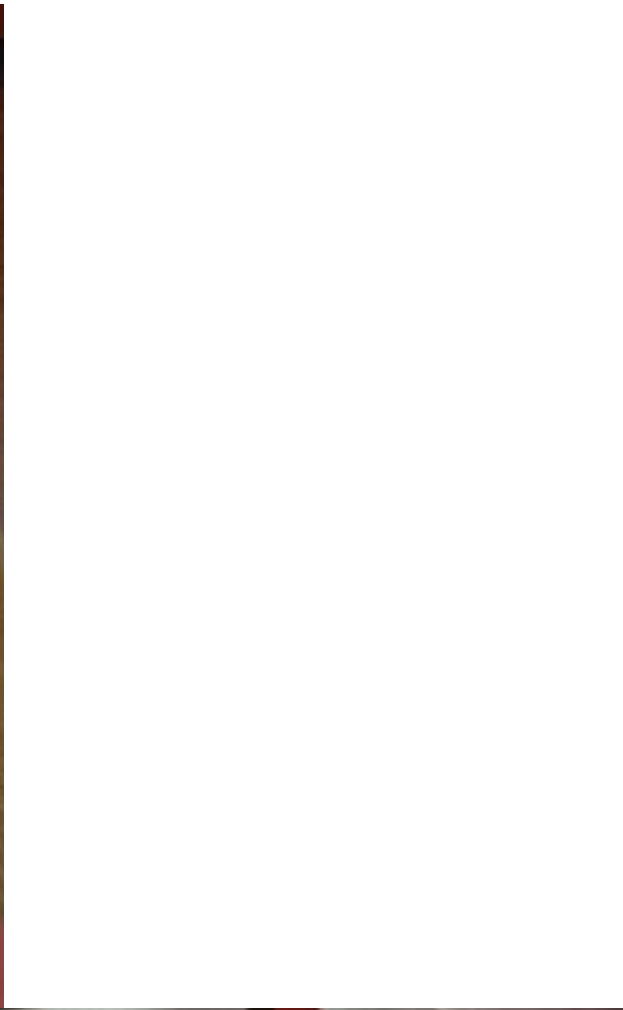
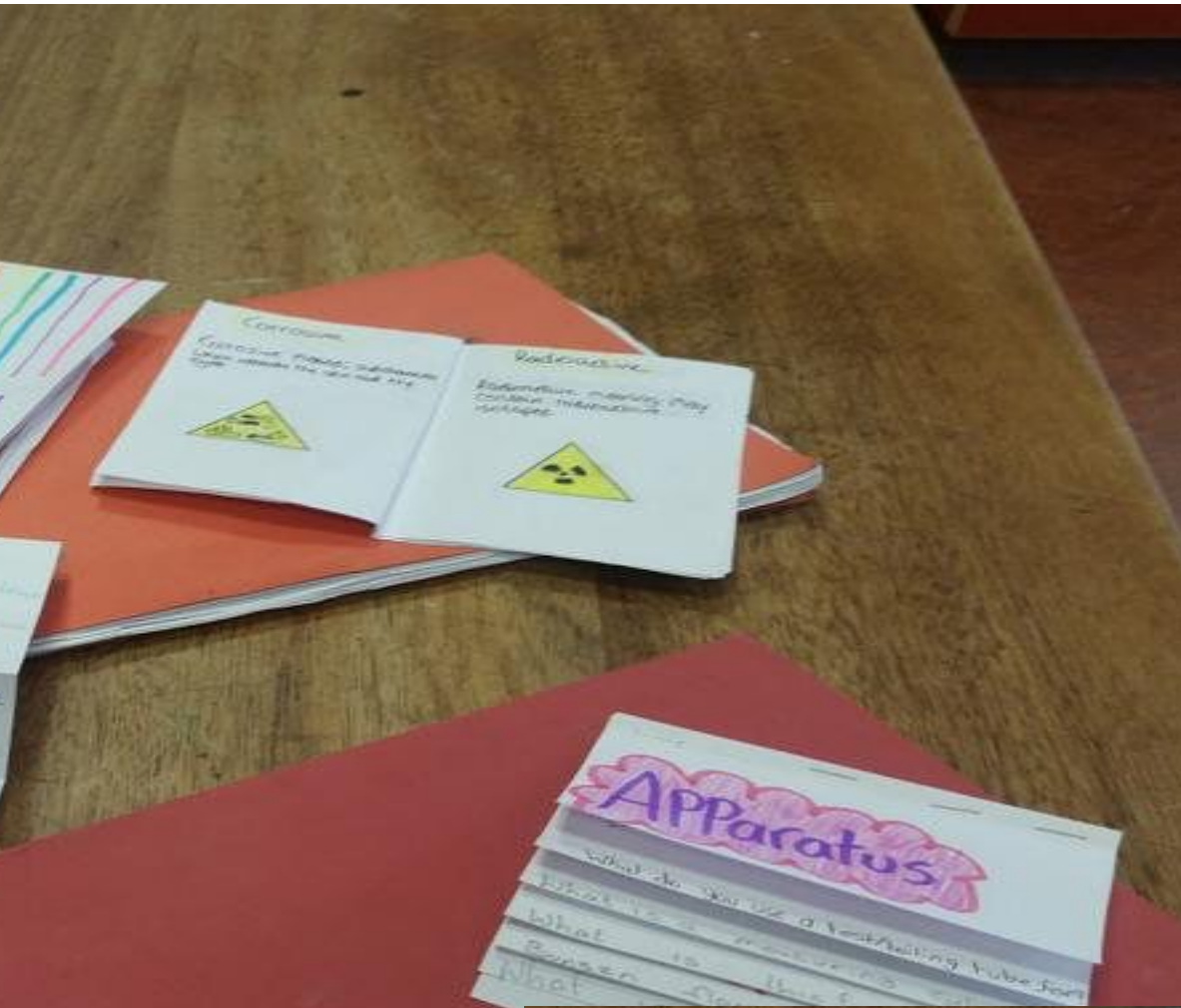


# Supporting your child during exams

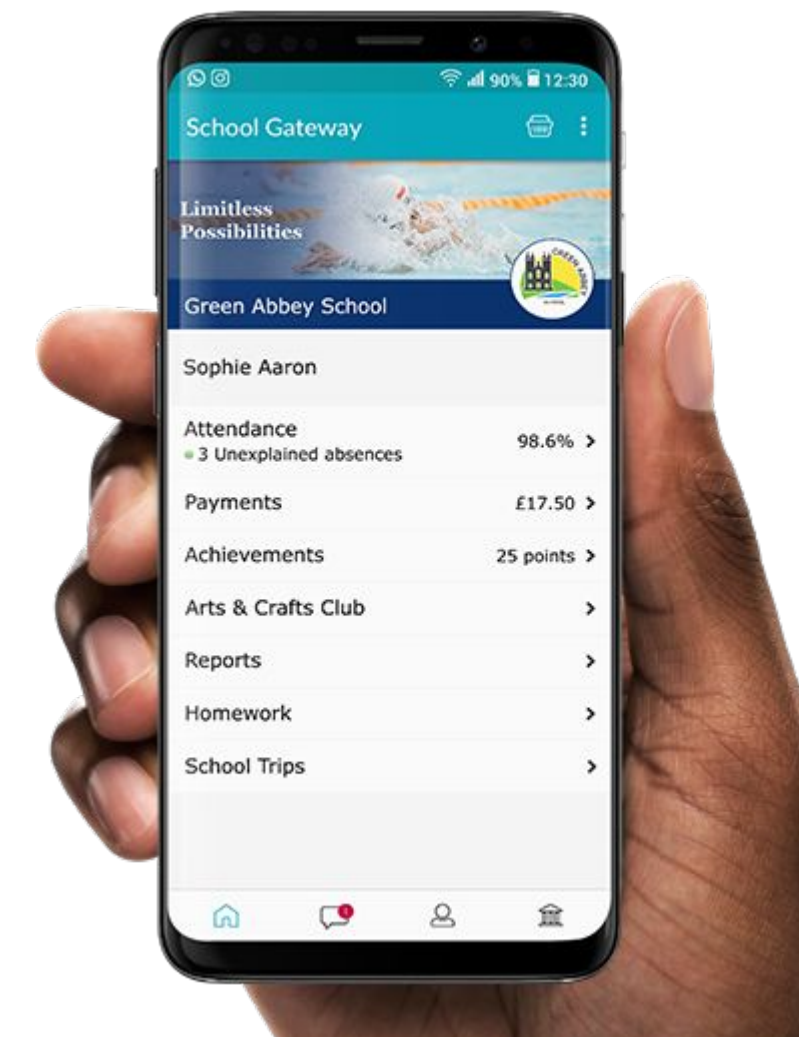

In 2010 24 hours before she died Charlene witnessed that dream come true as the contract was signed to completely rebuild Hidden Treasure School.

As a school we have fundraised nearly £60,000 over the last ten years.

Used to

- Build a kitchen, latrine block and teacher accommodation at the primary schools
- An irrigation and solar electric programme
- Starting the building of a secondary school.
