PAYMENT

The entry fee is £12, which includes a white T-shirt, sunglasses, and a powder pouch. This must be paid online via School Gateway.

WHAT IS A COLOUR RUN?

Participants all wear white T-shirts and throw coloured powder into the air at the start, creating a colour cloud that will cover everyone in powder. As they run pupils will pass powder stations where additional colours are thrown at the participants by designated staff. All the participants are advised to wear **old clothes** and trainers for the event as the powder may stain clothing.

BEFORE THE EVENT

Form teachers will collect hoodies in a bag before the event starts – please ensure these items are clearly labelled with your daughter`s name. Hoodies can be collected again after the event has finished.

If your daughter requires books and bags from her locker for the Easter break, she should be encouraged to bring these home on Thursday.

The powder conforms to EN-71-3 Standards and is made from corn starch, dyed with food-grade colouring. It is certified as non-toxic and non-irritant. All participants need to be aware that the powder will come into contact with their skin and eyes and there is a risk of inhalation. Participants may wish to wear sunglasses or face masks. **If they choose to bring their mobile phone, it should be protected inside a clear plastic bag.**

AFTER THE EVENT

After the run/walk an area will be designated to shake off the loose powder but we advise that car seats are covered before travelling home. **At the end of the event pupils will not be allowed back into the school building so pupils are reminded to carefully consider what items they will need for the day.**
