

HPV Vaccines

The School Immunisation Team will be visiting you child's school in the coming weeks, please see some information below...

Consent forms

School will be sending home consent forms over the next few days for your child's HPV vaccine – please look out for this in your child's school bag. Please read all information and return the completed form to school as soon as possible

Please return the form even if you do not consent to the vaccine or if your child has received the vaccine elsewhere

Should you consent to the vaccine but your child is absent from school on the day of vaccinations, we will offer a catch-up in school. This will happen in the summer term and we will arrange these dates with your school in due course

HPV vaccine

The HPV vaccine to all eligible children in Year 9. Some Year 10 children may receive a consent form if they **missed** their vaccine in Year 9

This vaccine is administered via injection in to the top of the arm. We ask that your child wear a short-sleeved school shirt or PE top to allow a smoother vaccination process for the child (at school's discretion)
