Dear Parents/Guardians,

As we approach the final month of this Academic Year could I ask a few things to be actioned please.

With the Data Collection forms being returned, there are several pupils with new medical conditions that have possibly been diagnosed over the last few months or were possibly omitted previously.

Could I ask if your child has any new medical issues or conditions that affect them or are diagnosed throughout any of the school academic terms that you make contact with me either via Gateway, written information or a telephone call please. This will ensure that I have up to date records for your child and can implement any changes or support if required.

Also there are quite a few pupils with prescribed medication that is held in the medical room, this will need to be collected and taken home by the end of June 2025 with new prescribed and in date medication handed over at the start of the new academic year in August/September 2025.

Unfortunately if any prescribed medication remains in school after the end of June, it will have to be disposed of safely and appropriately.

June is a busy month with two large activities that will take the majority of pupils off school grounds – Sports Day and the Uganda Dander.

I will be in attendance for both of these events however, can you ensure your child carries any prescribed medication they may need, i.e. Inhaler, EpiPen.
