The winter examinations are approaching. The exam timetables are attached for all Year Groups. Please note the following.

Junior School

A Study Guide will soon be emailed to all pupils and parents. We hope that this will provide your daughter with some helpful revision strategies and an overview of what will be assessed in each subject.

The majority of examinations will be sat by pupils in their form rooms. Some classes have been moved to another classroom, but pupils will be told in advance where they will sit the exams.

Junior school can go home at the end of their last examination session each day. Canteen will still be available as some Middle and Senior school will be sitting exams in the afternoon.

Middle and Senior School

These pupils only have to be in school when they have an exam. Year 12 examinations are for the full 2 weeks, beginning on Monday 17th November. Year 11, 13 and 14 examinations begin on Thursday November 20th.

GCSE Units

In addition to the School Examinations there are also some GCSE Units in November for certain Year 12 pupils.

<u>12th November</u> - Single Award Science (Physics)

14th November - English Language, Unit 1 (resitting pupils **only**)

<u>17th November</u> - English Language, Unit 4 (for pupils who study **only** English Language)

18th November - Mathematics, Unit 2, 3, 4 (resitting pupils **only**)

<u>20th November</u> - Mathematics Unit 6 (Mr Robinson's class **only**) and Unit 8 (resitting pupils **only**)

All Year groups will be back in class on Monday 1st December. Wishing all pupils well in these examinations.
