Year 12 AS/A2 Level Subject Choice Form

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Over the past number of weeks, there have been several events to support your child in making their decisions for AS Level subject choices. You have also been provided with a link to the AS and A Level Subject Choice book. We hope you have found these beneficial.

Please use the link below to nominate 3 or 4 subjects **in order of preference**. These will be the final subject choices which School will use to create the curriculum offer and timetable for 2026-27.

We will try to provide the combination of subjects chosen by pupils, but we cannot guarantee that this will happen. If there are timetabling difficulties with a chosen combination of subjects or insufficient pupil numbers, it will be necessary to discuss this with pupils and for them to revise their choices.

Individual Subject Requirements

- For any subject they wish to take to A Level, pupils will be expected to meet the GCSE grade and other requirements specified for that subject.
- Page 11** of the subject choice book details the GCSE grade and other requirements for entry into each AS subject.

3 or 4 AS Level Courses

- Pupils are expected to study a minimum of 3 AS subjects.
- The majority of pupils will study 3 AS Levels.
- Pupils should note that a minimum of 20 GCSE points is required if they wish to study 4 AS subjects.

4 AS levels

- A minimum of **20 GCSE points**.
- Individual entry requirements should be met for each subject.

3 AS levels

- A minimum of **12 GCSE points**.
- Individual entry requirements should be met for each subject.

The deadline for completion of this form is **Friday 20 February 2026**.
